## EXERCISE 4: Accommodation contract comparison

Your contract is really important. It will have many consequences for your pension entitlement; eligibility for rent assistance; money available to invest; ability to afford the lifestyle you want now and in the future; and - if the need arises - your financial position in accessing and affording aged care. You'll need to work out if the contracts you are considering represent a fair balance of rights, responsibilities and costs. This exercise helps you compare contracts, and makes sure you don't focus on just one element of the contract.

1. Create a table for each of the options you are considering.
2. List your rights and responsibilities in the respective columns.
3. Break it down into the three time zones, as shown: before you move in, while you live there and when you leave.
